Ambrosius Crono represents a fusion of precision and refinement, with features designed with meticulous attention to detail.

The push-button at 2 o'clock serves as a central control unit for the watch's chronograph. By using this button, you can start and stop the chronograph, which accurately displays 60 seconds in the central dial. The minutes are recorded in the left dial, while the right dial, dedicated to the watch's operation, presents an accurate 24-hour display.

The crown of the Ambrosius Crono is a multifunctional component with two distinct positions. The first position allows for a quick change of the date. It is important to proceed with caution to avoid damaging the date-changing mechanism, especially when the 24-hour hand approaches 24 during the watch's date change period.

The second position of the crown allows for precise adjustment of the watch's hands. It is essential to ensure that the 24-hour hand is correctly set; otherwise, the watch will change the date at noon.

When using the push-buttons with the crown pulled out, care must be taken as this can affect the zero point of the chronograph. Any errors can be corrected by pressing the button at 4 o'clock to reset the time backward. The button at 2 o'clock advances the time, and it is recommended that the minute hand in the left dial is set to 30 while the second hand in the central dial is set to 60 for optimal operation.

The Ambrosius Crono is not just a watch; it is a carefully designed timepiece created to impress with its precision and user-friendliness.
